

Fair Lawn Heavy Rescue Squad, Fair Lawn, New Jersey

One of many public buildings designed by Joel Ives, The Fair Lawn Rescue Squad is a two story masonry building finished with residential siding. Despite the building's emergency mission it was designed to be sensitive to the community. Approximately 3000 square feet per floor, it houses vehicles, equipment, offices, training area, and support facilities for the Rescue Squad. The building is used for fundraising functions. Joel Ives developed the initial design concept and presented it to the Zoning Board for approval. This is a volunteer organization ruled by committee that Joel Ives guided through the construction process.
